### What to Expect on SAT Testing Day

**Parking:** You are allowed to park in the lot next to the Alexander Music Building. This is the only lot available to us this year. There are a few metered spaces a block west of the building on East Circle Drive. Allow plenty of time to find the building and a parking space.

Meter Fee: \$1.75/hour, for a maximum of 2 hours.

**Check-in:** Hand this form to a volunteer at the check-in desk in the lobby of the Alexander Building. Student will receive a student ID sticker at this time.

**Testing:** Students will be escorted to each testing room either by a parent or by someone from the SAT Staff. Allow 2 hours to complete tests. The student will be free to leave after all tests are finished and the final “Check Out” is completed. Please make sure that all parts of the testing have been checked off on the badge before you leave the building.

**Music Scores:** Students must bring a published copy of each of the three pieces they will perform. If student is using music downloaded from the Internet, you will need to provide proof of purchase and a Digital Release Form signed by your teacher. Unauthorized photocopies of music are not allowed and will disqualify students from participating.

Do not share music with other students.

Bookmark the pages in the music to find easily and write in measure numbers in the left margin for judges to easily reference your music score. .

When you receive your student SAT ID number, make sure to write it in your music for identification.
